A once a week opportunity to enrich your life through singing!

Your voice is a musical instrument that goes with you where ever go.

Learn the basics of music that will prepare you to sing in a church choir or join the chorus in your school.

Learn how to read music (the dots on the paper), speak in a foreign tongue, sing in harmony (like the Pentatonics) and work cooperatively in a group setting. Just like in sports your voice becomes part of a team!

Our singing lessons will be based on a program that comes from Europe. - The (English) Royal School of Church Music. As you progress there will ribbons and awards as you gain confidence in your singing. What does the singing sound like? Look up and listen to the singing at Prince William's and Princess Kate's wedding. - BEAUTIFUL !!!

Once we get the group going we hope to sing once a month at Mass at St. John's and perhaps at other parishes as we grow more confident in our singing. Maybe even sing a concert for the neighborhood or go Christmas Caroling!

Mr. Kevin Chun, our director, is also the music teacher at Hallahan Girl's High School and they sing their Masses at the Cathedral of Ss. Peter and Paul on the Parkway.

The choir is open to middle school and high school students, and those who may be younger who can read most of the words in the church hymnals.
